A. Eligibility

The Housing Authority of Pompano Beach (HAPB) Scholarship is open to any **first-year college student in their second (2nd) semester** who resides in HAPB's federally subsidized housing (preference is given to students living in Golden Acres, Ben Turner Ridge, Golden Square/Golden Villas, and HAPB Section 8 participants).

Eligible applicants must:

- Be enrolled full-time in a U.S. undergraduate program
- Be in their **second semester of their freshman year of college at the time of application**
- Have earned a **minimum 3.0 GPA** during their first semester of their freshman year of college
- Provide an official **college transcript** as proof of GPA
- Maintain residency in HAPB housing at the time of application

Scholarship funds will be awarded for use starting in the student's **sophomore year**.

B. Application Procedure

Applications will be available at the at the Housing Authority of Pompano Beach office beginning April 21, 2026. Completed applications and all required materials must be submitted to: **Housing Authority of Pompano Beach**, 321 West Atlantic Boulevard, Pompano Beach, FL 33060, no later than **June 22, 2026**.

A complete application must include:

- An official college transcript showing GPA
- One reference letter
- A copy of your school picture ID
- A brief personal statement describing how this scholarship will support your educational and career goals

C. Selection

The HAPB Board of Commissioners Scholarship Committee will review all applications and select the scholarship recipient(s). Selection is based on:

- Demonstrated academic achievement
- Community service involvement
- Verbal communication skills
- Resume quality
- Strength of reference letter

Scholarship awards will range from **\$1,000 to \$5,000**.

D. Payment

The scholarship fund will be managed by the HAPB Board of Commissioners Scholarship Committee. Funds will be sent directly to the educational institution upon verification of full-time enrollment each semester.

The first disbursement of the scholarship award will occur during the student's sophomore year, as follows:

- 50% of the scholarship award will be disbursed for the first semester of the sophomore year.
- The remaining 50% will be disbursed for the second semester.

This disbursement process will continue for the duration of the college student's attendance, up to a maximum of four (4) years. This is an achievement-based scholarship with a four-year limit. To continue receiving the scholarship in subsequent years, students must maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0 and remain enrolled full-time.
